





Introduction to Loblaw




- Clarity is mainly used for Project Management, Labor/Time Tracking and CapEx/OpEx Forecasting
- Community is composed mainly of external IT contractors, who will track time or manage projects
- Resource information is fed from the IDM solution, which only contains base information
- All data is eventually sent over to several financial applications and extracts for stakeholder reporting
- PMO Team is in charge of handling the high amount of data and need to ensure its quality and accuracy, while facing the challenges of:
 - Incomplete data coming in
 - Diverse and rotating user community



Introduction

- This architecture causes a series of challenges:
 - PMO Team needs to supervise and guarantee resources are fully configured before providing access
 - PMO Team needs to ensure PMs are following the business processes for multiple modules like financial plans, status reports, etc.
 - Ensure financial processing is up to date, as reports and external financial systems are fed periodically with Clarity data



Data Integrity





Importance of Data Integrity and Quality

- Data Integrity and Quality monitoring helps organizations:
 - Ensure data is being properly entered into the system
 - Ensures data is consistent, accurate and completely filled out
 - Can aid data security and governance by validating the processes followed to enter data into the system
 - Helps identify common pitfalls like duplication or lack of integrations
- Well implemented protocols translate not only into better adoption, but also confidence in the application
 - Production of repeatable, reliable outputs (Portlets, Reports, Extracts)


Example of Data Integrity Metrics

- Active Resources not open for time entry
- Active Projects in a completed state
- Projects without status reports
- Missing rates for Resources
- Missing financial fields in Projects and/or Resources
- Projects with rate matrix associations
- Projects/Resources with OBS associations
- Incomplete timesheets
- And much more

Loblaw's Data Integrity

- Allows us to configure rules that align with their business and categorize them by criticality, modules and
- Creates an "data exception" per violation, allowing organizations to automatically assign owners and ensure issue like tracking
- Provides metrics and trending on incidents and completion of the incidents

Data Exceptions Dashboard






Business Rules – Required Fields

Project Managers were creating Cost Plans on investments that were missing some key data




Created a business rule to high Financials tab until all prerequisite data was populated
