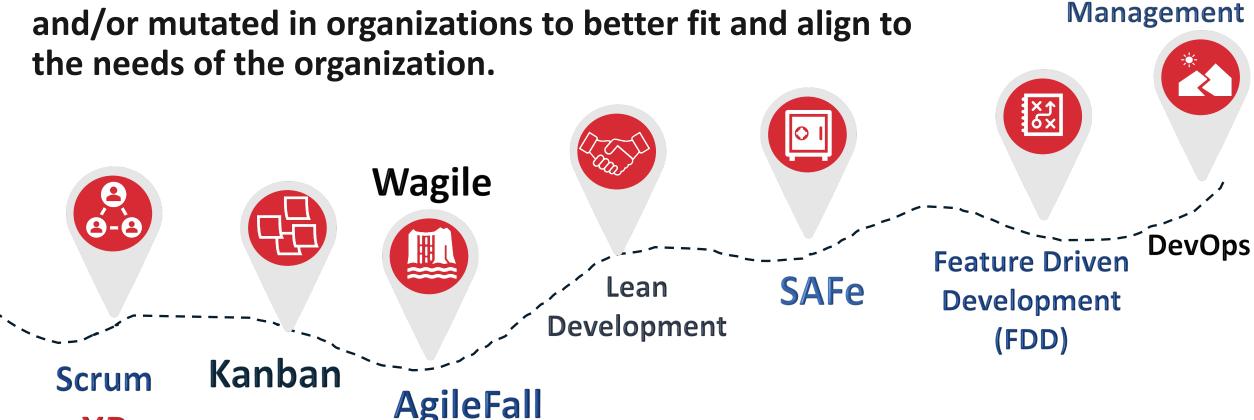

# An Agile Revolution and Evolution

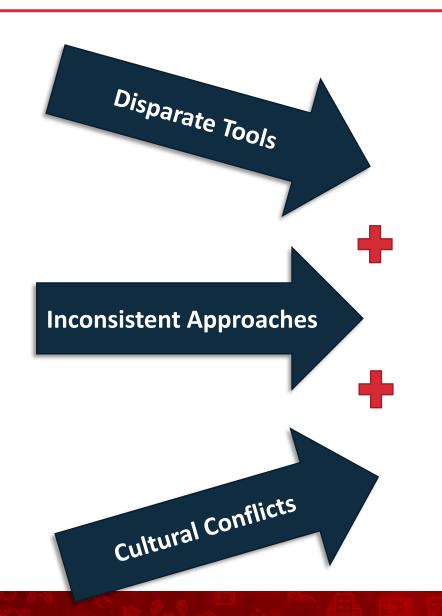
XP

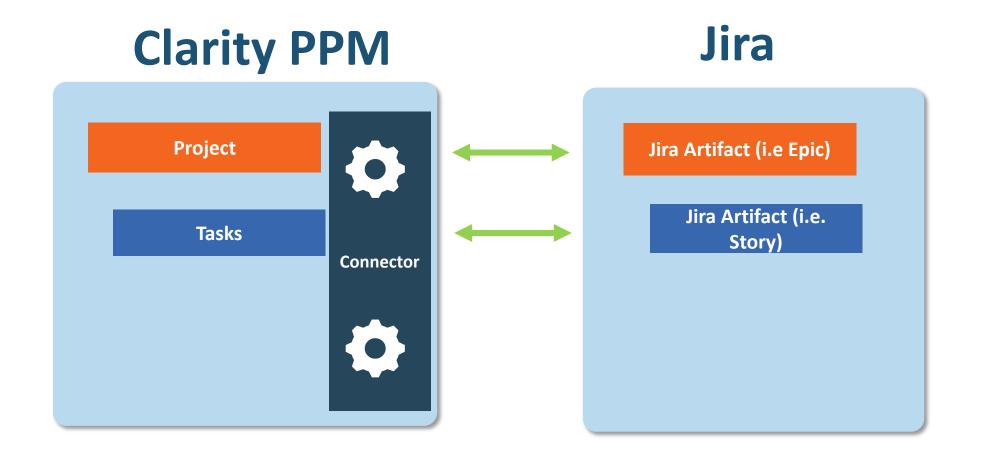

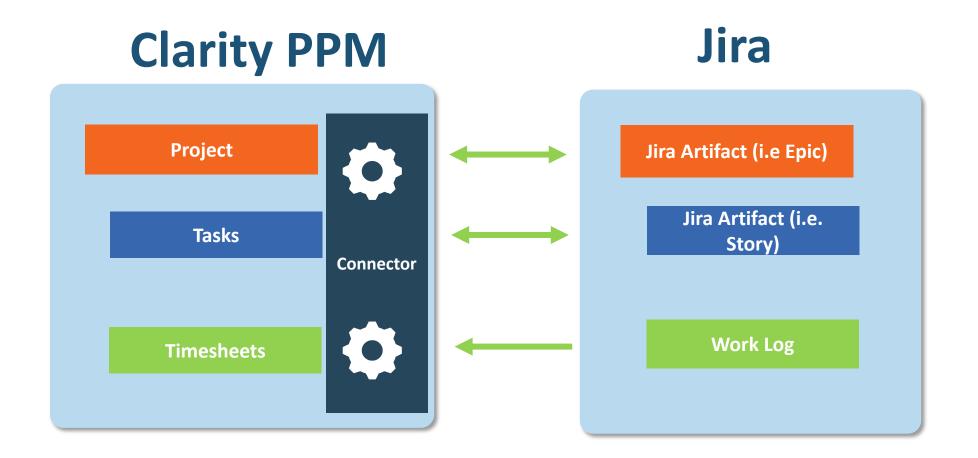




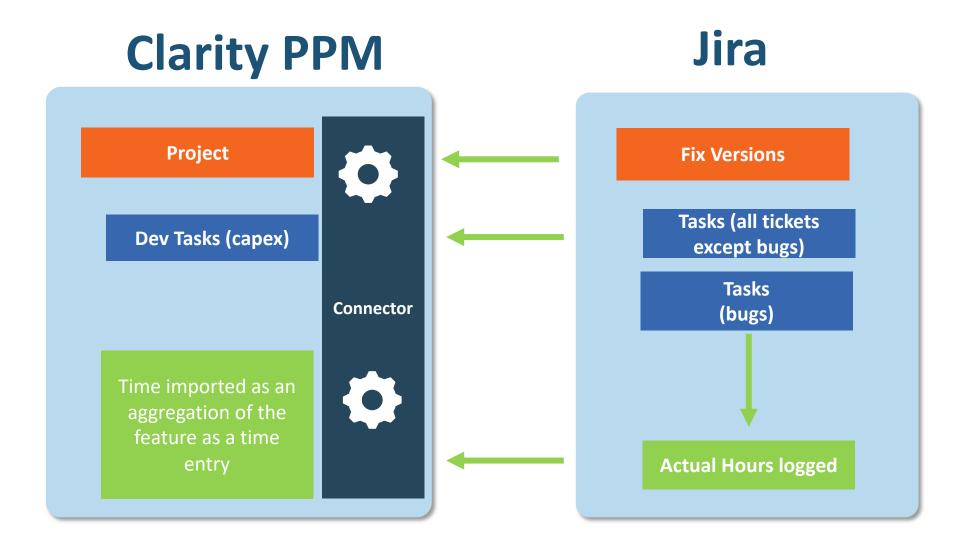
# Standard Approach — Standard integration of Jira and Clarity



# Standard Approach (part 2) — Standard Jira with Worklog



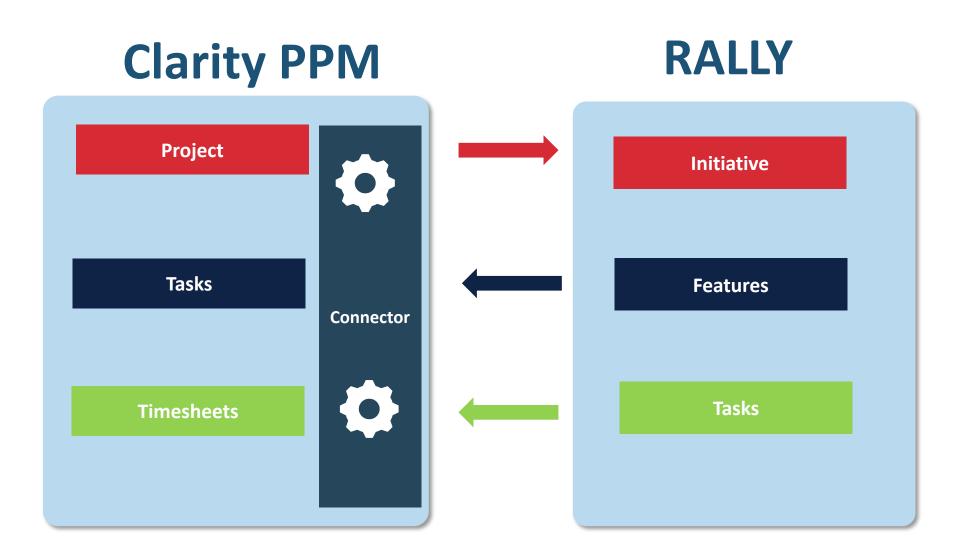

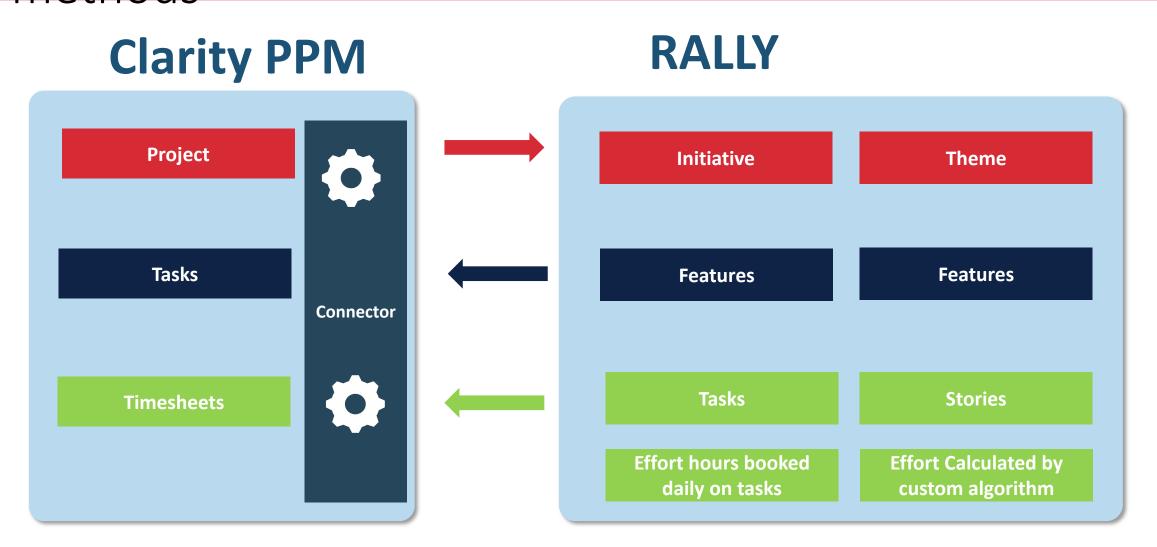

## Rally + Jira Integration Solution Options

**Conceptual Overview** 

**Basic Integration Implementation** 

- Less than 200 projects in Rally
- 50 Rally projects per connector instance
- Designed to connect one Jira instance per connector instance
- Support synching defects, tasks, stories, test cases and base level portfolio items (Epics/Features)



- Ideal for more than 200 Rally Projects
- Designed to Scale to 3000 Rally projects
- · Designed to connect to multiple Jira instance
- Supports synching defects, tasks, stories, test cases, Portfolio Items, Iterations



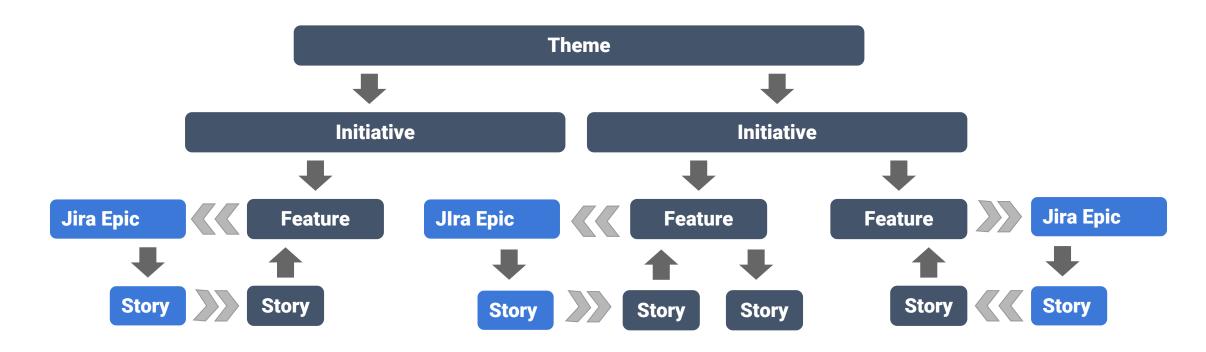

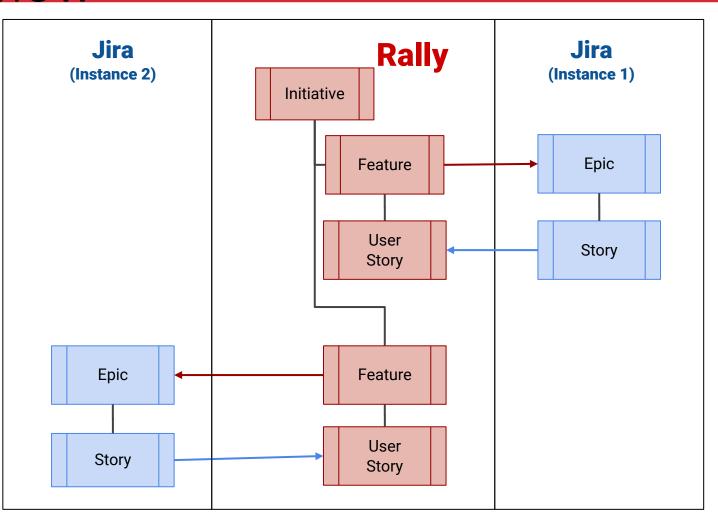
# The Rally Adapter for Jira detailed

Visualizes and tracks work across an organization's Jira instances and projects in line with your Rally teams, providing a comprehensive view of planned and in-progress work across your execution teams.



#### Recommended Workflow

- Create/originate Features in Rally that are synced into JIRA Epics.
- Epic updates may flow back from JIRA to Rally if there is some execution team refinement of feature data expected.
  - While not required, ideally features **should** be originated in Rally if that is where planning is taking place.
- In some scenarios, the execution teams want to clone a feature, or break a feature into multiple features in JIRA.
  - If this scenario is prevalent, then Features/Epics may originate in both systems.
- Depending on where the execution teams like to break down their features/epics, Stories can originate in JIRA or Rally.
- If stories only originate in JIRA, there is likely not value in syncing stories or updates from Rally to JIRA, so a unidirectional sync is recommended.
