- Downloaded pre-made resource mgmt report & started editing to our specific requirements. Download acerated our learning of how data was model in database.








Publish Expectations with Power BI & Power Automate

Clarity Reporting | Process Workflow





Provides a clear, visual breakdown of project workflows, including:

- Current statuses
- Volume of items in each stage
- Ownership & durations

Identifies bottlenecks & efficiency opportunities:

- Highlights stages with high task volume or long durations
- Improves handoffs for long approvals that slow progress
- Assists stakeholders in making data-driven decisions for where to invest in process improvements
