







Top: Navigation Bar




Notifications (Bell icon)

- Simple MUX (configurable) notifications
- Timesheet notifications
- Action Item notifications
- Queued data export notifications with attachments



Personal Menu (Avatar icon)

- Account settings
 - Profile
 - General
 - Notifications
 - Proxy
 - API key generation
- Impersonation (if admin)
- Context Help
- Logout

Contains links to major functional areas of Clarity




Is customizable, and can be configured to have links to specific pages

Settings -> Navigation Menu





Visible menu options depend on:

Settings -> Home Page






Middle: Main Screen Area

This is the frame where the loaded module or functional component will be display



A module's initial landing page is typically either:

- A Grid Layout (e.g. Projects)
- A Tile Layout (e.g. Administration) with drilldown tiles to sub-components of the module




The Common Grid





Common Grid: Action Bar




- 1. Actions Menu
 - Import / Export grid data
 - Execute Process-driven actions
- Template button: Invokes Create-From-Template dialogue
- 3. Quick Search: Search by *Name* and *ID* only
- 4. Expand filter: show/hide filter options
- 5. Change view (timeline, board, grid)

- 6. Conditional Formatting
- Show/Hide widgets (configurable in Blueprint)
- 8. Views: save, share, load customized grid views
- 9. View Options
 - Configure view settings
 - Define Picklists


Common Grid: Features

- Edit and Delete multiple rows
- Copy / paste data, drag values
 - Limited to data between rows of a column when column is lookup-based
- Group by columns
 - Collapse and summarize by expandable groups
- Column sizing
 - Auto-size by data widths
 - Manual: Drag column size per column
- Shift + Click: Multi-column sorting (up to 4 columns)
- Right-click cell whitespace vs. Right-click cell hyperlink
 - Whitespace: Invokes Clarity context menu
 - Hyperlink: Invokes browser context menu
- Flyouts
 - Column: Select columns that should appear in the grid
 - Details: View a single record's details in a blueprintlike format



Common Grid: Filtering

- Q Column filtering
- Filter groups for nested filtering rules
- In-column filtering and aggregation




Blueprint Screens





Blueprint Screens

- Contain detailed data for a single record
- Tabs to sub-objects, channels, reports, etc.
- Based-on 6-column "Responsive" framework
- Contain expandable/collapse-able sections
- Rich Text fields contain a WYSIYG editor
- Lookup-based fields can be configured with auto-suggest values and expanded, multi-column LOVs
- Data is saved on the fly without "Save" button
- Data is refreshed on the fly (in most cases) when background processes update onscreen values
