Blueprints as a philosophy:



A blueprint is a complete, high-level plan for a solution that shows how all its parts should be organized and work together

Design for User Experience:

Implement the business process into your blueprint

Control what the user sees and inputs by phase

"The system should speak the users' language, with words, phrases, and concepts familiar to the user, rather than system-oriented terms. Follow real-world conventions, making information appear in a natural and logical order."
